Mr. Campbell leads the litigation practice of Miller, Miller & Canby and has been with the firm since 1997. He became an equity partner in the firm in 2005. In the process, he has developed relationships with representatives of the State Department of Assessment and Taxation (SDAT), which help facilitate the appeal process.
